## **ARE YOU JUST BEGINNING?**

Zechariah 4:10 Amplified

Everything big begins with something small, and your attitude in the beginning often determines your success in the end. The Bible says, 'Who (with reason) despises the day of small things?' Delight in what the LORD Jesus gives you to start with and thank Him for your small beginnings.

Before the drought ended and the rain came, Elijah saw a cloud the size of a man's hand (1 Kings 18:44). That's pretty small, but he rejoiced over it because it was a sign of bigger things to come.

Don't destroy your seed by doubting its potential. God gives you a seed of hope, something small - but something is better than nothing. Take that seed and plant it, praying over it and believing the LORD for the increase. Do not throw your seed away.
